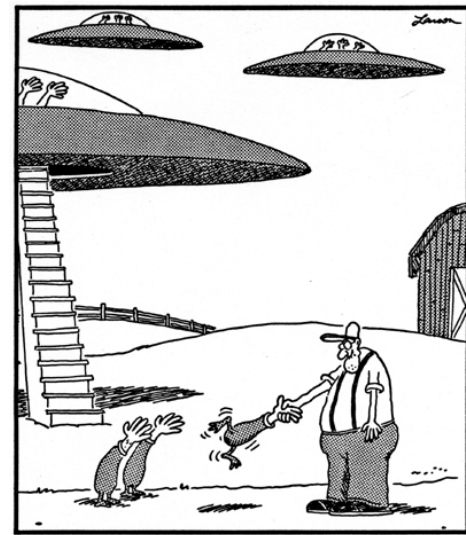

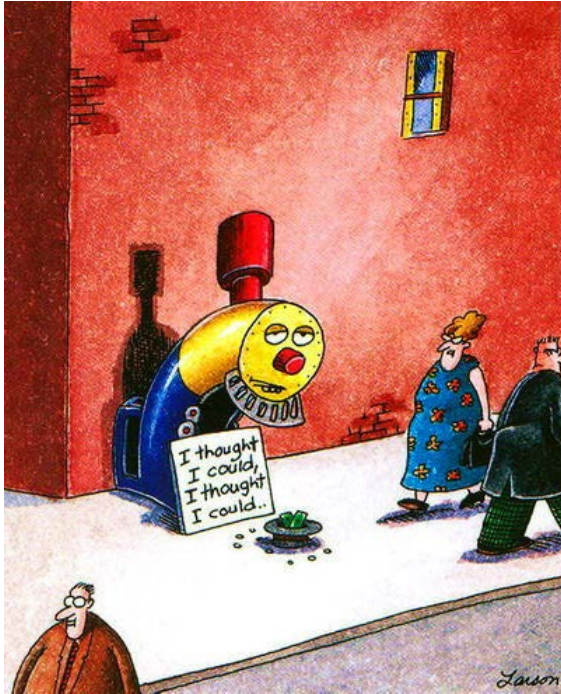

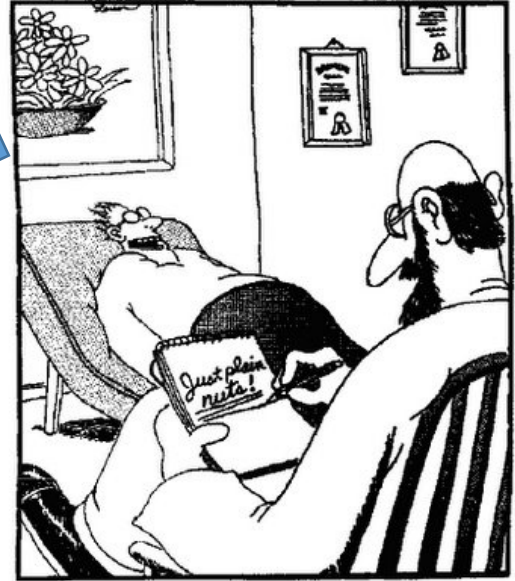


How we process your feedback
